As cold weather is about to hit us, please make note of what determines an inside day here at our school. For air quality, when Particulate Matter (PM2.5) is above 90, an inside day is called. PM2.5 levels are checked at [www.airquality.utah.gov](http://www.airquality.utah.gov). When precipitation occurs that would cause students to be wet, and inside day is called. When the temperature is 20 degrees Fahrenheit (counting wind chill), an inside day is called. Orange flags are posted out the front entrance and east entrance when an inside day is called signaling students are to enter the school when they are dropped off. Please direct comments regarding inside days to the School Community Council- contact information is listed on the school's website.

At our school we are working to help our students be good problem solvers through the instruction they receive. Please get in the habit of asking students what they are studying in class and give them opportunities to implement what they have learned.
