

# Falcon Award Requirements

Showcase your leadership skills by completing 9 required and 9 optional goals for a total of 18 ways to show your most proactive self.

All green items will be done at home throughout the year. Note the \* stars and their key below. No star means the item will be tracked by the teacher and she will mark it off when completed.\* One star means that the item can be completed at home and a parent note to teacher will be notice of completion

\*\* Two stars means that the item is to be studied, practiced, read, etc. then a note from home lets the teacher know the student is ready to pass it off at school. Reading minutes are to be recorded nightly in the planner.

\*\*\* Three stars - the student must do the action and then write about it and turn their writing into the teacher.

Red are headings for the 9 required goals in the three areas. Yellow are the headings for the optional goals in each area. The students will need to complete three optional goals in each of the three areas. That means they need to complete 18 goals overall. This is a yearlong process. Those students who think they can complete it in the last couple of months of school will be disappointed.
