Minutes

October 4, 2018

Meeting was called to order at 3:45p.m.

Introductions of members present were made.

We discussed the current inside day rules. These rules are set by the community council and the state. Our current threshold is 20° including wind chill. Air quality inside days are determined by the state and can be accessed at <https://air.utah.gov/> The members of the community council feel like the current standards are working for our school. Marianne Dwyer motioned to vote to keep the standards the same for the upcoming school year.
