## Math

Focus: I can solve addition and subtraction equations

Example: Help your child write out simple math equations and solve them. In class we have learned to follow 4 steps to solve equations.

1. Look at the first number and draw circles
2. Look at the sign is it + or -
3. Think about what the sign means (should I draw more circles or cross some out?)
4. Count the number of circles left and write the answer

## Language Arts

Focus: I can read and write sight words

Example: Keep practicing sight words at home. These words are important in help your child learn to read. Remember when your child has mastered a set of words, bring them back to school to earn their ice cream scoop.

Help your child practice spelling/writing the sight words too. This is very helpful when they write at school.

\*Our goal is to know 13-18 words by mid January (end of quarter 2).
