



Upcoming Grade-Level Events




• November 28, 29, & 30: CogAt Assessment-6th grade students will be taking a test for Middle School. Students need to be at school on these days, if possible.

Math

Focus: I can do measurement in one unit and I can decide whether it takes more or less of a different unit to measure the same quantity.

Example: If we measure the same quantity with different units, it will take more of the smaller unit and fewer of the larger unit to express the measurement. For example, a room that measures 4 yards in length will measure 12 feet.



<u>Language Arts</u>

Focus: I can study the details of characters actions to determine the central theme or central idea.


Example: The author of the realistic fiction story, "The Boy who saved Baseball." wrote it with a message about life for readers to understand and remember

Science

Focus: I can describe the effect of gravity exerted by the Sun, moon and Earth.

Example:

Gravity is a force of attraction between two objects.
ALL objects with mass exert gravitational force
The more massive the object, the more gravity exerted by the object.



Social Studies

Focus: I can analyze the earliest civilizations like Egypt, which created technologies and systems to meet community and personal needs.

Example: Ancient Egyptians invented many things we still use today like clocks, the 365 day calendar, and many more. As well as, a practical system of medicine and irrigation system
