<u>Math</u> Focus: I can tell when groups are "equal" (=) or "not equal" (≠).	Language Arts Focus: First Sound Fluency - Isolating or saying just the beginning sound in words.
Example: Equal means "the same as". Four bears equals four bears. Four bears equals the number 4. The number 3 does not equal two pencils. Five markers equals five crayons.	Example: You say "bug" your child says /b/(the sound not letter name). You can help your child by practicing this skill at home, in the car, during playtime. Say any word and have them tell you the beginning sound. *Our goal for the end of December is to say 40 beginning sounds in one minute. **Read with your child daily** Talk about the vocabulary words in the story and the events that are happened.
You can practice this with your child by having them identify whether two groups are equal or not equal. You can also give them one group and have them come up with ways to make another group that is equal or not equal.

Focus: I will be a true friend.

Example: One of the things we are doing in school is sorting leaves. Sorting is an important skill to master. Having your child sort things like socks or letters can help them develop critical observation skills.
