Antarctic fish have "antifreeze" proteins in their blood to tolerate cold water temperatures.

In class, we are analyzing mealworms and determining if they have successfully adapted to their environment in our classroom. We are also studying the survival adaptations of Green Anole lizards in Mrs. Earl's classroom terrarium. how they impacted colonization.

Example:

The three geographic areas are Rocky Mountains, Basin and Range Region and the Colorado Plateau. Students are discussing which areas offered the most resources for settlers.
