Home Connection: Have your children look for shapes in the house that they can measure and compare between cm and in. Ask your students how many sides are in these shapes: quadrilateral, pentagon, and hexagon.	Some vowel sounds are not categorized as long, short or r-controlled. These vowels sounds are called "other" vowels.
