Focus: I can write to share my opinion and provide reasons that support my opinion. I can write to inform or explain topics or ideas to others clearly.

We are honing our writing skills as we prepare to take our end of the year tests. We are focusing on writing 5 paragraph essays, including a good introduction and conclusion. Each essay also needs 3 good body paragraphs with concrete details and reasons.

Science

In science we teach the following units.

Did You Know?
