Math

Focus: Fraction Fun! Students will be able to add and subtract fractions, find equivalent fractions, and change a fraction "greater than one" to mixed numbers.

Example:

Check Understanding

Write two fractions with the denominator 20: one equivalent to $\frac{1}{4}$ and one equivalent to $\frac{7}{10}$.


$$\frac{1 \times 5}{4 \times 5} = \frac{5}{20}$$
 $\frac{7 \times 2}{10 \times 2} = \frac{14}{20}$

Language Arts

Focus: Text Features in informational text.

Example:

Students will analyze graphs and diagrams in text and relate information in text to deeply understand nonfiction text.



Science

Focus: Students will be able to describe how animals adapt to their environment.

Example:

Carnivores often have some type of camouflage so they can blend into environment to better hunt prey.

Social Studies

Focus: Students will be able to explain a local current event and how it impacts community.

Example:
