Example: Using objects or drawing pictures, have your child show the different teen numbers as a group of ten ones and extra ones. Then have them write an equation to match. 00000 0000 10+4=14	Example: In kindergarten we have learned narrative writing (tells a story), informative writing (what I learned about a topic) and opinion writing (stating opinion and reasons). Give your child a topic and have them write a sentence. If your child can easily write a simple sentence, encourage them to write multiple sentences with additional details. Encourage them to spell sight words correctly. All other words can be spelled by writing the sounds they hear.
