Language Arts

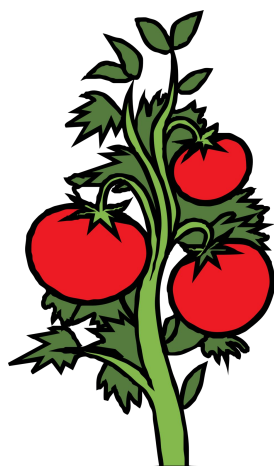
In Module one of our new program, Wit and Wisdom, we are looking at and answering the question, "Why do people explore the sea?"

Focus: We will be rotating again for Science. Students will be learning from a different 3rd grade teacher for the next 3 weeks. The following is the topic that they will be studying.

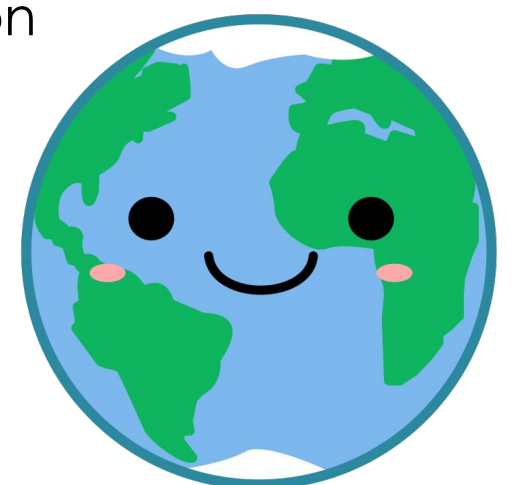
Water and Climate- Mrs. Steenblik
