




#### **Math**


**Focus:** I can learn to identify, measure, and draw angles in a circle.




What is the meaning of the word draw as used below?

**Focus:** How can a star map help you identify night-sky constellations?



#### **Example:**

A constellation is a group of stars that appear to make an image in the night sky.

Constellations change their orientation and location based on the time of year and time of night. Having a tool to help you find constellations at any time of year can be helpful.

**Focus:** We are learning about the differences between rights & responsibilities of Utah citizens.
