**Focus:** I can explain the relationship between different place value positions in a number with two or more digits.

**Example:** In 8,685, how much greater is the 8 in the thousands place than the 8 in the tens place?

**Answer:** The 8 in the thousands place is 100 times greater than the 8 in the tens place.

# **Language Arts**

**Focus:** I can provide at least one detail or example when explaining what the text says explicitly

**Example:** After reading the text <u>Swamp</u> <u>Amphibians</u>, explain how frogs survive and hide from their enemies. Use details from the text to support your answer.

**Answer:** Frogs use camouflage to survive. In the text it says that frogs blend in with the swamp around them to hide from their enemies.

#### Science

**Focus:** I can analyze cause-and-effect relationships with circuits to explain how electricity works.

# **Example of Making Connections at Home:**

Investigate the flashlights in your house. Are they working? Open them up and check the batteries. What orientation are the batteries in? What size batteries are they?
