
## **Grade-Level Events**

- No school Friday, September 16 Professional Development for Teachers


### **Math**

Focus: I can understand multiplication by thinking about a equal number of objects in a specific number of groups. For example 3 x 6 is the same as 3 plates (groups) with 6 cookies on each plate.

Example:  $3 \times 6 = 18$  3 groups of 6=18 6+6+6=18







# **Language Arts**

Focus: I can show understanding by asking and answering questions by referring back to the text.

Home Connection:

As your student reads at home, ask questions about what they read. Follow up those questions with where in the text they found the answer or have them explain how they know the answer.

#### **Science**

Focus: This year 3rd graders will rotate through three different science units. They will be learning about Motion and Matter, Water and Climate, and Structures of Life. The following are the units that will be taught by each 3rd grade teacher.
