Focus: I can understand and solve word problems	Focus: I can ask and answer who, what, where,
using addition and subtraction strategies.	when, why and how questions about a text.
Home Connection: Think of situations at home where you can make up a word problem for your child to solve for different unknowns. Have them write an equation and be able to explain how they did it.	Home Connection: As your child is reading their 20 minutes a night, ask them questions. *Challenge them to ask you questions about the story.
For example: If I read for 8 minutes Tuesday night and 7 minutes on Wednesday, how many minutes did I read all together? 8+7= Strategies: doubles, make a 10, count on, etc.	 Who is the story about? What is happening? Where is it taking place? How does it make them feel?
