Grade-Level Events

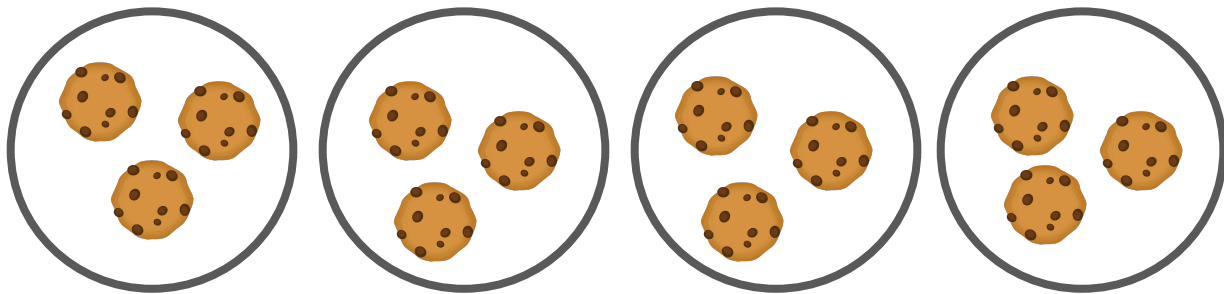
- Flex Friday on September 10 (attendance is optional- We will not be taking attendance) Our focus will be "Mastering Magnificent Math Multiplication"

Example: $12 \div 4 = 3$



Language Arts

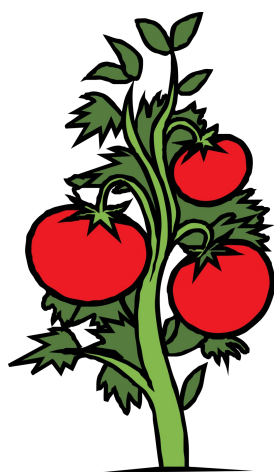
Focus: I can show understanding by asking and answering questions by referring back to the text.
