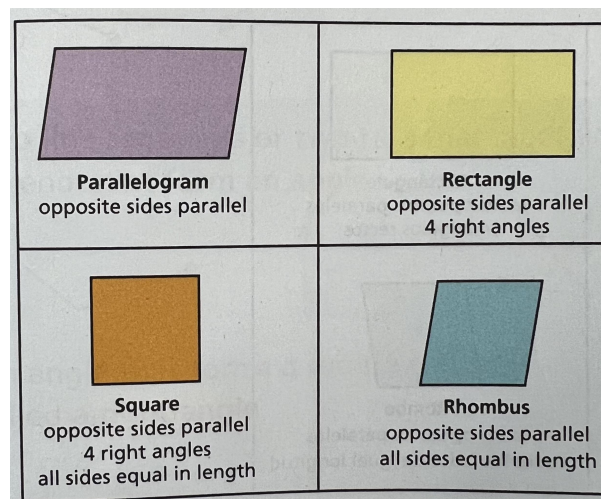
Grade-Level Events

We are continuing our study from Module 2 in Wit and Wisdom about space.

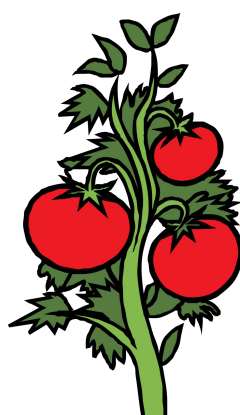
We are improving our writing skills with providing evidence from the text.
