Language Arts

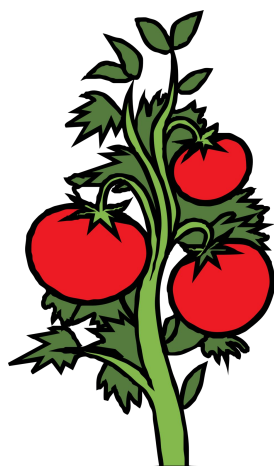
In Module one of our new program, Wit and Wisdom, we are looking at and answering the question, "Why do people explore the sea?"
