


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

* Kindergarten – Important Information

We are so excited to welcome your little ones to Kindergarten next year! Please read through the following information. If you have any other questions, please call the office at 801–446–3200.

Registration: ** The registration process is very easy. Click on this link <u>https://planning.jordandistrict.org/enrollment/</u> and complete the online registration. Once you have completed the registration you will need to provide us with your child's <u>original</u> Birth Certificate, Immunization records, proof of residency (lease agreement or mortgage statement) and picture ID. We will make a copy and return the originals. We have a cute backpack with some prizes for your child when you come in!

Check out: **If you need to check your child out during the school day you may call a few minutes before you arrive; however, you must come into the office and show your picture ID. Attendance: ** Please try to be on time each day, and especially for pick up after school. Your little ones get really worried if you're not there when school has ended. If you're going to be late, please communicate with either the teacher or the office, so we can reassure your child that you haven't forgotten them. If your child is going to be absent, please make sure you call the office so they can be excused. Also, please be aware there is no supervision for students before school starts.

Vacation/Education Leave Form: ** Each student is allowed 10 Education/Vacation Release days each year. If your child will be missing more than 3 days of school, please stop by the office to fill out this form prior to the vacation dates.









Kindergarten – Important Information Continued

Emergency Contacts: ** Please make sure when you complete your registration that you list emergency contacts other than parents. Emergency contacts may not excuse a student's absence nor check them out of school. However, an emergency contact may pick up and/or deliver a student only when a parent/guardian authorizes that person to do so. The authorization should be done by a phone call or email to the school.

Volunteers/Visitors: ** At this time we are not allowing any volunteers or visitors. If that changes we will let you know and provide you with the information you will need to sign up. Lost & Found: ** Please, please be sure to label all of your student's items with their name and phone number. Our lost and found is often bulging at the seams. If your student has lost something, please have them check the lost and found.

Weather: ** Students will be lining up outside in the morning, and going outside for recess when the temperature is 21 degrees or above. This temperature takes into account the wind chill factor. Please make sure your student is dressed appropriately.

Air Pollution: ** On "Red" air quality days, all students will remain indoors. On "Orange" days, students with lung sensitivities can remain indoors.

Beginning of the Year Checklist

Your child should be able to do these listed items before starting Kindergarten:

- Zip their jacket - Tie their shoes - Use the restroom independently - Wash hands correctly - Write their first name - Name 12 or more upper and lower case letters
- Name 6 alphabet sounds

- Count from 0-20

- - (thumb up)







- Recognize and Write Numbers 0-5 - Count at least 5 objects - Name the four basic shapes: Circle, Square, Triangle, and Rectangle - Identify the colors: White, Black, Brown, Red, Yellow, Blue, Green, Orange, Purple Pink - Hold a pencil and scissors correctly
