Standards-based grading is a system of assessing and reporting, that describes, student progress in relation to standards. It's an effective way to give feedback and evaluate students' performances using clearly defined criteria for specific learning standards. When you join us at Parent Teacher Conference, you will gain insight to where your child is in their learning and progression toward the mastery of standards that teachers have taught. Parent Teacher Conferences will take place the first and third term, that's when students will get to share their learning progression of power standards. Grades can be accessed throughout the year using skyward. Report cards can be printed at the end of each semester (second and fourth quarter). We understand this is very different from what has been done, before, in the past. We will be here to guide parents through the new process.
