## **Math**

**Focus**: I understand the relationship between addition and subtraction.

I understand the meaning of the equal sign and I can make an equation true by filling in the missing number in an equation

I can add and subtract fluently within 20.

**At home:** Ask students to represent one and two digit math equations. Master math facts.

## **Language Arts**

**Focus:** I can read words with digraphs, blends, trigraphs and long vowel sounds spelled with silent e. I can read fluently with accuracy, phrasing, rate, and expression.

**Writing**: I can write an informative paper using a topic sentence, 3 to 4 details, and a closing sentence.

**At home:** Have your student read out loud to you.

#### Science

**Focus:** Living things (plants and animals, including humans) need water, air, and resources from the land to survive and live in habitats that provide these necessities. The physical characteristics of plants and animals reflect the habitat in which they live. Animals also have modified behaviors that help them survive, grow, and meet their needs. Humans sometimes mimic plant and animal adaptations to survive in their environment.

### **Social Studies**

**Focus:** Standard 1 Culture Students will recognize and describe how people within their community, state, and nation are both similar and different.

We will also be working on school and classroom expectations.
