Our coaching and student achievement goal also align with our new district curriculum, Wit and Wisdom. We will be taking the year to focus in on bettering our reading instruction.

Action Steps

1. We will offer professional development and curriculum/unit planning days for teachers to dive into Wit and Wisdom
2. We will pay for subs to cover classes for teachers to have time to observe each other and/or provide this time to meet during PLC
3. Our coach will be present to guide teachers during this professional development time
4. We will continue running Walk to Read (funding mostly supported by Landtrust).
5. We will coach specifically to high leverage literacy strategies
6. We will purchase student incentives for Walk to Read to help with student buy in and behavior
7. We will use funds to update student and teacher technology
