  - Literacy Assistants for 95% Program that will begin next month for K-3.

- We were excited to hear about the new school in Jordan District next year that will solely be for online students. They will have their own principal and own teachers.
- With TSSA money we pay teacher stipends for the extra learning/training they get and the Literacy Specialist. The teachers all agree she is a great resource and want to continue working with her.
