1. TSSA

- a. Walk to Read assistants are paid with TSSA: the program is working at our school - 55% moved up one level, 20% moved to enrichment, 25% staying on level – 21% of those are resource children and a big influx of recent move ins

2. Landtrust

- a. Great Artist Program: teach about artist about 15 minutes, watch video on how to do and then students work on learning an art concept. \$1800 will purchase online version with one lesson a month for the whole school, an assistant could administer the program and free up teacher time, prep materials could be purchased at the district warehouse to help reduce cost

3. Yearbook Update
